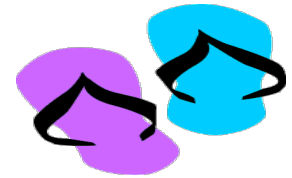




CHANCLA TOSS CONTEST



Location: Kids Zone

Participants acknowledge there may be a RISK of INJURY while participating in Chancla Toss.

Individuals Participate At Their Own Risk

General Rules

1. Cost: Three tosses for \$3.
 2. The count begins when the first throw is made.
 3. All throws must be attempted from behind the throw line.
 4. A toss is considered “thrown” when Chancla leaves hand in forward motion.
 5. Participants who toss 1 or more chanclas through the corn hole will win a prize.

HISTORY OF THE CHANCLA

In a Mexican household, when the kids would get into TROUBLE, for example, mouthing off, misbehaving, etc.; or The wife found out the husband was cheating or misbehaving, the mom/wife would take off her chancla, now known as a “flip flop,” and throw it at the child or the husband as punishment and to let them know she knew what they had done!

LOL!! Of course, this doesn't happen in Mexican households any longer.....shhhhhhhh.
